The works submitted to the editor's office will be reviewed, therefore, you are asked to send two copies of the article (one for the editor and one for the reviewer), and a floppy or a file delivered in an electronic way to *Bulletin of Geography. The authors are kindly asked to make sure the files sent by e-mail or on a floppy are identical with the final version of the submitted text.

The title page should only contain the title without the author's name and start in the twelfth verse, and then the text formatted according to the rules.

A separate sheet of paper should include the author's name and surname and the full name and address of the institution with the telephone, fax, and e-mail addresses. If there are several authors you are asked to indicate the main author responsible for correspondence. If the main author has not been indicated the first listed will play that role.

Articles are accepted for consideration on the understanding that they are not being submitted elsewhere. After submission of the text the Authors receive a "brush" and they may either return it without comments or send it with a list of corrections in due time.

In the *Bulletin of Geography. Socio-economic Series* (semiannual), there is a wide array of articles published every six months. The topics of papers published in the Bulletin range from theoretical to empirical investigations into social and economical geography dealing with issues of diverse spatial scales – local, regional, national, and international.

The articles of both domestic and foreign authors are always new, never printed before in other scientific publications. All the articles are reviewed.
